CMS EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS RULES WEBINAR

WEBINAR DESCRIPTION

With the November enforcement date quickly approaching nursing facility providers must understand and implement this massive regulatory requirement. Disasters can strike at any time and with little warning and these events call for clear cut plans and strategies for accessing the resources necessary to protect the health and welfare of your residents. Under the new regulations, CMS requires skilled nursing facilities to (1) assess facility risks and improve emergency planning, (2) implement supporting policies and procedures, (3) develop and maintain preparedness communication plan, and (4) a comprehensive training and testing program. CMS is set to begin enforcement of the Emergency Preparedness Rule beginning November 15, 2017. The deficiency tags for emergency preparedness will be "E" Tags found in Appendix Z. With more than 40 "E" tags providers have substantially more to and accessible to both health and safety surveyors and LSC Surveyors. State survey agencies will have discretion regarding whether the LSC or health and safety surveyors will conduct the emergency preparedness surveys. This webinar will provide an overview of all the components that must be put into place by November. Participants will walk through conducting a hazard vulnerability assessment and detail how to develop policies and procedures designed to help complete an all-hazards approach risk assessment and establish an effective emergency plan. This webinar will explore the CMS initiative including a template of the requirements for facility's requiring facilities to perform a risk assessment that uses an "all-hazards" approach prior to establishing an emergency plan. Key components of a communications plan – Nursing Home Incident Command System and necessary protective actions for a facility's disaster and emergency plan and operating procedures will be discussed as well. With November quickly approaching, it's time to get on board with preparations and modifications necessary for meeting these requirements. All HCAM facility members are encouraged to participate!
