CIENA HEALTHCARE’S REGENCY AT WATERFORD BREAKS GROUND TO UNDERGO EXPANSION

*Significant investment made to skilled nursing center to accommodate demand
for short- and long-term care*

SOUTHFIELD, Mich. – Nov. 10, 2014 – Ciena Healthcare, a leading manager and operator of skilled nursing and rehabilitation centers in Michigan and Connecticut, recently broke ground on newly purchased land to expand its Regency at Waterford skilled nursing center.

Located at the northwest corner of Telegraph and Dixie Highway, this American Health Care Association (AHCA) Bronze award facility is adding more private rooms and doubling the size of its rehabilitation gym. At an estimated total cost of \$4.5 million, the expansion at Regency of Waterford is scheduled to be completed in September 2015.

“We are excited to have this expansion project underway,” said Brad Peruski, administrator, Regency at Waterford. “When completed, we’ll be able to welcome more individuals to our state-of-the-art center for high quality care.”

As part of the expansion, Regency at Waterford will increase its current 65,000 sq. ft. of space by nearly 17,000 sq. ft. It also is adding 32 private rooms, including four bariatric rooms, bringing the total number of beds to 150, all in a one-story setting with an easy-to-navigate floor plan and a homelike look and feel.

Regency at Waterford features a living area designed to care for the needs of residents requiring a short-term rehabilitation stay and contains a separate living area designed to meet the needs of traditional, long-term care geriatric residents. It includes a kitchen/dining area, library, recreational area, lounge and a salon. The community also boasts an Executive Chef, providing nutritionally balanced meals, 24-hour room service and a private, fine dining room for family gatherings.
