Medical service providers such as hospice providers, podiatrists, dentists, durable medical equipment providers, social workers and other behavioral health providers, speech pathologists, occupational therapists, physical therapists, and other health care providers, including resident physicians and clinical students. Non-medical service providers, such as hairdressers, nail salon technicians, cosmetologists, and providers of religious or spiritual services.	No	No	Yes, in all counties
